Rules for all entries:

1. Candy must be handed out and not thrown into or at the crowd.
2. Participants distributing information must walk along and keep up with their specific entry.
3. Water guns or super soakers are not permitted.
4. Children in the parade must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Parade marshals will be present along the parade to ensure safety and to keep the parade moving. You are required to follow their instructions. Please be respectful of these volunteers and the police who will be assisting them.
6. The Village of Hinsdale is not responsible for any of your entry's actions.
7. Your participation is contingent upon the receipt of your signed entry form and the appropriate payment.
8. Parade modifications such as wearing of face coverings, social distancing, etc, may be put into place and must be followed.

Rules in addition to the above for business entries:

1. Business entries are allowed a maximum of three vehicles.

Rules in addition to the above for political entries:

1. Maximum of 3 vehicles or 1 float.
2. Negative campaigning is not permitted.
