



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

May 27, 2020

Project Description

The Village's contractor, Linden & Sons Construction will begin the **2020 E Chicago Ave Corridor Drainage Project** on **Wednesday, May 27, 2020**. The project initially involves the installation of new drainage structures and storm sewer on Orchard Place, Elm St, and Oak St. Pavement reconstruction will follow during the early summer. Due to the complexity of the construction operations, **ALL affected streets will be closed (to thru traffic) from First St to E Chicago Ave until mid-July.**

The **storm sewer construction** is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, May 27, 2019 and is expected to be completed by Tuesday, June 30, 2020 (Weather Permitting).

Impacts to Residents

The scheduled storm sewer activity will take place from **7:00 AM to 4:30 PM**. During the project activity, street parking on Orchard Place, S Elm St, and S Oak St will be prohibited daily (7:00 AM through 4:00 PM).

Alternate Parking Locations

Residents located within the project limits will need to park at alternate locations (daily and overnight), due to the construction activity.

- Orchard Place alternate parking locations will be E First St (Elm St to Oak St)
- Elm St alternate parking locations will be E First St (Park Ave to Elm St)
- Oak St alternate parking locations will be E First St (Oak St to County Line Rd)

The Village's Police Department has been notified of this alternative parking arrangement for daily and overnight periods.
