



# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

July 23, 2020

## Project Description

The Contractor will be performing sanitary sewer main lining on **Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup> thru Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup>** weather permitting. The lining will begin on S Elm St, proceed to Orchard Place, and end at S Oak St. Sewer lining is a trenchless process that allows for reconditioning of existing sewers without opening up the streets or parkways. The process involves inserting a resin infused fabric liner (sock) into the sewer main via the man holes. The ends are sealed and high pressure steam is used to inflate the liner. The steam activates the resin and the fabric becomes rigid after a few hours of cure time.

## Project Locations

### **Sanitary sewer runs east-west through property easements.**

(See attached map for affected properties - highlighted in yellow)

- S Elm St (24 S Elm St & 25 S Elm St)
- Orchard Place (22 Orchard Pl & 15 Orchard Pl)
- S Oak St (8 S Oak St & 14 S Oak St)

## Impacts to Residents

The sewer lining operations will take place from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Although thru traffic and street parking will be prohibited, the north and south ends of the street will be open (south end access only for Oak St). Use of the sanitary sewer will be limited for ALL properties on each street. Since the liner will be covering all service connections to the main, sewer flows from each home will be restricted during the day. We request that residents limit the use of dishwashers and washing machines during the day. **Use of showers and toilets will be allowed.** Once the lining cures, cutting tools will be sent through the main to open up all the individual house service lines. Please consider these sewer restrictions as you plan your activities for Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup> & Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup>. *This process emits a chemical scent that is harmless and will diminish over a few days.*

## Alternate Parking Locations

Relocating your vehicles will not be necessary, except for the properties listed above. Please use First St for daily alternate parking. Access will be restored every evening for the affected properties. The Village's Police Department has been notified of this alternative parking arrangement for daily periods. ***Residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines.***

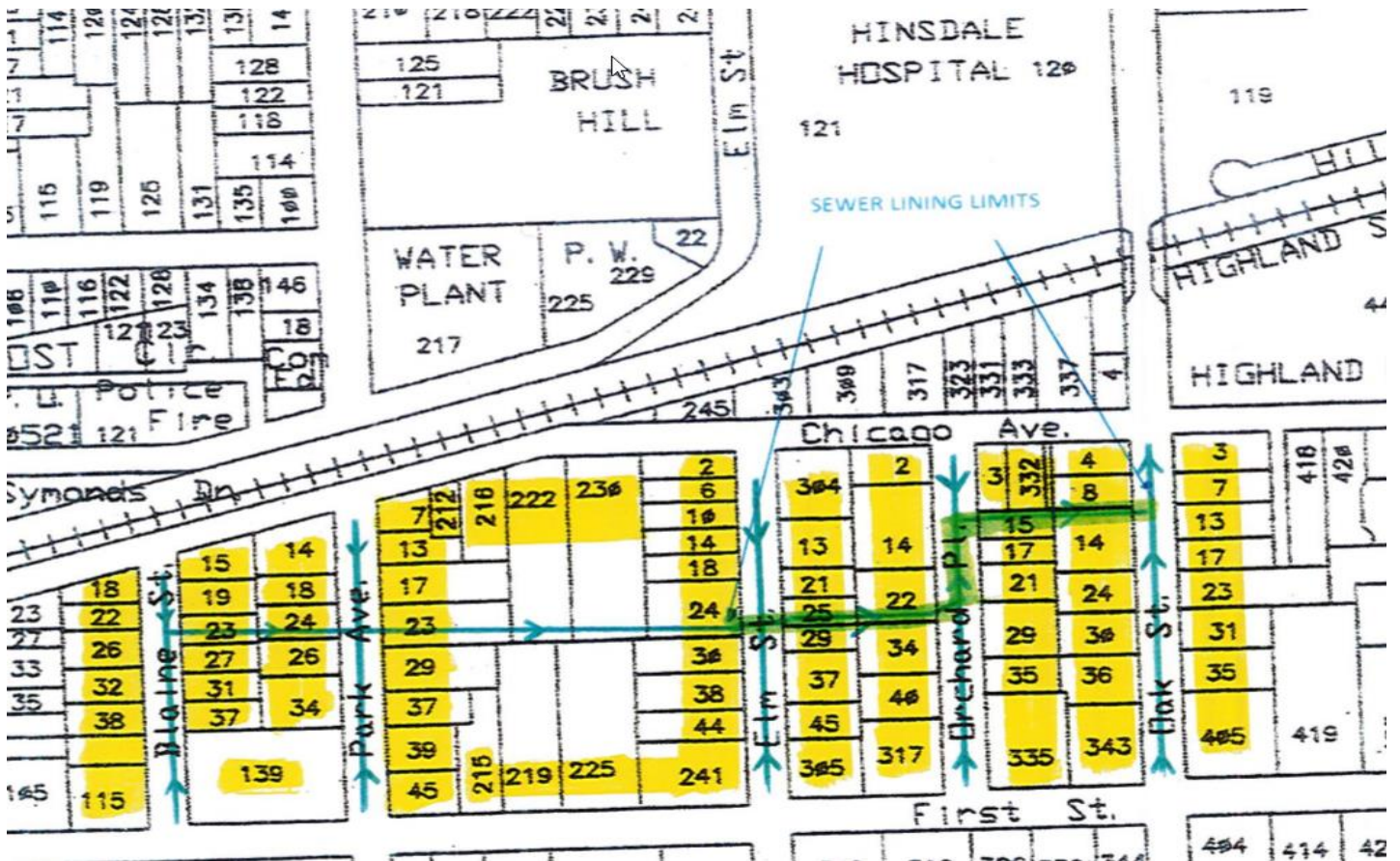

Properties highlighted in **yellow** are requested to limit their use of the sanitary sewer on **August 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>**. The section of the sewer to be lined is highlighted in **green**. Properties west of Elm St will not be impacted by construction activity (sewer lining). However, the sanitary sewer main will have limited capacity during the lining process. Please limit your use of the sanitary service during this activity period (**August 5<sup>th</sup> – August 6<sup>th</sup>, 7AM to 7PM**).
