



UTILITY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

October 6, 2020

Project Description

NLP Construction (a Nicor contractor) will begin replacing the existing 8" gas main on the east side of **Adams St (Chicago Ave to Maple St)** on **Monday, October 12th (weather permitting)**. The scope of work will involve parkway excavations near both intersections. The new main will be directionally bored between the excavated pits to reduce parkway and driveway disturbances. **Pipe View** crews will be verifying the integrity of existing sanitary sewer services (using cameras) for the remainder of the week. These operations will require a partial street closure and street parking will be prohibited for the duration of this work. The contractor will mobilize equipment and materials to the project site on **Friday, October 9th**.

Project Locations

- North Adams St (Chicago Ave to Maple St)

Impacts to Residents

The construction operations will take place from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. During the project activity, street parking in the vicinity of the construction activity will be prohibited. Adams St will experience partial closures which may temporarily delay resident travel. In order to avoid conflicts, residents may use Maple St (east of Adams St) as an alternate parking location. Maintain a 50 foot clearance from the intersections. **Access to all properties will be restored at the end of each day. For everyone's safety and to expedite the construction process, residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines.**

Alternate Parking Locations

- Maple St (50 feet east of Adams St)

The Village's Police Department has been notified of this alternative parking arrangement for daily and overnight periods.
