



UTILITY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

November 23, 2020

Project Description

ALL SOURCE DIRECTIONAL BORING (a Leducor/Verizon sub-contractor) will begin the installation of a 2" conduit, via directional boring, on the east side of **Madison St (55th St to 9th St)**, south side of **9th St (Madison St to Lincoln St)**, and the east side of **Lincoln St (9th St to 2nd St)** on **Monday, November 30th (weather permitting)**. The scope of work will involve parkway excavations near ALL intersections and six locations along the project route. The new infrastructure will be directionally bored between the excavated pits to reduce parkway and driveway disturbances. **ALL SOURCE** crews will be verifying the integrity of existing utility locations and depths with "pothole" excavations in the parkway and street. These operations will require temporary/partial street closures for the duration of this work. The project is scheduled to be completed by: **December 15th (weather permitting)**

Project Locations

- South Madison St (55th St to 9th St)
- 9th St (Madison St to Lincoln St)
- South Lincoln St (9th St to 2nd St)

Impacts to Residents

The construction operations will take place from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM (Monday – Friday). During the project activity, street parking in the vicinity of the construction activity will be prohibited. Some streets will experience partial closures which may temporarily delay resident travel. In order to avoid conflicts, residents should use alternate side streets. Maintain a 50 foot parking clearance from the intersections.

Access to all properties will be restored at the end of each day. For everyone's safety and to expedite the construction process, residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines.

The Village's Police Department has been notified of this project schedule and route.
