



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

April 5, 2021

Project Description

Builders Asphalt will begin their street resurfacing improvements on the **2021 Maintenance Resurfacing Project** on **Monday, April 12, 2021 (weather permitting)**. The scope of work will involve limited curb and gutter repairs, pavement milling, pavement patching, and pavement resurfacing. These operations will require partial street closures and street parking will be prohibited. The contractor will mobilize equipment and materials throughout the site for the duration of the project. Builders Asphalt anticipates completing this work by **July 16, 2021 (weather permitting)**.

Project Locations

RESURFACING STREETS (April thru July) – in street order

1. **N York Rd** (Ogden Ave to Glendale Ave)
2. **W Maple St** (Monroe St to Grant St)
3. **Philippa St** (Minneola St to Bob O Link)
4. **W Third St** (Grant St to Washington St)
5. **W Eighth St** (Quincy St to Jackson St)
6. **S Quincy St** (Eighth St to Melin Park, including Parking Lot)
7. **S Washington St** (Seventh St to Eighth St)
8. **Robbins Park Parking Lot** (off of Eighth St)

Impacts to Residents & Businesses

Construction operations will take place from **7:00 AM to 5:00 PM (Monday – Friday)**. During the project activity, street parking along the project route will be prohibited. Partial street closures are to be expected, which may temporarily delay travel through the work zone. In order to avoid conflicts, residents may use alternate side streets for daily and overnight parking. **Access to all properties will be restored at the end of each day. For everyone's safety and to expedite the construction process, residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines. Residents with corner lots are requested to mark the locations of their sprinklers heads in order to limit damages during the sidewalk ramp repair operations. The contractor will be responsible for repairing sections they damaged.**
