



# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

May 21, 2021

## Project Description

The Village contractor, **John Neri Construction**, will resume water service transfers on **W Chicago Ave (Vine St to Quincy St)** on **Friday, May 21<sup>st</sup> – Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021**. The contractor will notify each resident 20 minutes before the transfer. Each service transfer will take about 90 minutes to complete. The contractor will use an outdoor spigot to flush the service line after the connection is made (if available). Residents will need to bleed the air out of their interior plumbing by removing the faucet screens and running water for a few minutes. Once the air is flushed from the faucet, you may then flush the toilets. **Do not flush any toilets until all the air is bled out of the faucets.** If you experience a loss in water pressure, please contact the Water Dept. (630-789-7053) to schedule a meter inspection.

The water service transfers are scheduled to be completed by **Friday, May 28, 2021**. (weather permitting)

- May 24<sup>th</sup> - May 26<sup>th</sup> - W Chicago Ave (Monroe St to Adams St)

- May 28<sup>th</sup> - W Chicago Ave (Vine St to Clay St)

## Impacts to Residents

Construction activities will take place from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. During the project activity, parking will be prohibited. Access to the street and driveways will be affected by construction operations. Prior to the water service installation, the contractor will perform exploratory excavations to determine utility conflict depths. The Contractor will directional bore the new water service to the new water main on the south side of the street. Measures will be taken to limit damages to the lawn. All disturbed areas will be restored during the parkway restoration activities.

Please use alternate side streets to avoid any conflicts with these activities. ***Residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use extreme caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines.***

The Village's Police Department has been notified of this activity.
