



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Project Description

J Nardulli Concrete has submitted their project schedule for the **2021 East Eighth St Reconstruction Project**. The scope of work will involve some watermain replacement (Oak St to County Line Rd), curb/gutter and asphalt pavement construction, and parkway restoration. These operations will require partial street closures and street parking will be prohibited. The contractor will mobilize equipment and materials throughout the site for the duration of the project. J Nardulli anticipates completing this work by **October 10, 2021 (weather permitting)**.

Project Locations

- East Eighth St (Garfield St to County line Rd)

Project Schedule (weather permitting)

- June 8th – June 11th – Construction Layout, Tree Protection Measures, and Traffic Control Installation
- June 14th – June 25th – Watermain Installation and Water Service Transfers (Oak St to County Line Rd)
- June 28th – July 12th – Storm Sewer Improvements
- July 12th – August 13th – Pavement Removal and Road Base Excavation & Stabilization
- August 16th – September 3rd – Concrete Curb & Gutter and Driveway Apron Construction (**8th St Driveway Access Prohibited**)
- September 6th – September 17th – Asphalt Street Paving (Binder and Surface Paving)
- September 20th – September 30th – Pavement Striping and Parkway Restoration
- **October 10, 2021 – TARGET COMPLETION DATE (weather permitting)**

Impacts to Residents & Businesses

Construction operations will take place from **7:00 AM to 5:00 PM (Monday – Friday)**. During the project activity, street parking along the project route will be prohibited. Partial street closures are to be expected, which may temporarily delay travel through the work zone. In order to avoid conflicts, residents may use alternate side streets for daily and overnight parking. **Access to all properties will be restored at the end of each day, with the exception of curb paving operations (residents should plan accordingly).** *For everyone's safety and to expedite the construction process, residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use caution. Maintain garbage and recycling routines. ALL residents are requested to mark the locations of their sprinklers heads (and invisible dog fences) in order to limit damages during the sidewalk and curb operations. The contractor will be responsible for repairing sections they damage.*
