Standpipe Rehabilitation Project

The Hinsdale Standpipe was constructed in 1956 by Chicago Bridge and Iron and is located adjacent to Hinsdale Central High School. The 2,000,000 gallon standpipe is roughly 100 feet tall and serves as water storage, system pressure fluctuation control and fire protection provider for the Village of Hinsdale. Water tanks/standpipes are typically rehabilitated every 15-20 years. This critical piece of infrastructure was last painted in 2001.

The Standpipe was inspected by Nelson Tank Engineering & Consulting, Inc. in the summer of 2022. The inspection report recommended the complete removal of the Standpipe's interior and exterior coatings by sandblasting the surfaces down to bare metal. The interior will be coated with an epoxy system while the exterior will be coated polyurethane The with paint. Standpipe will be covered with containment shields during the work.

The Village Board awarded a contract in the amount of \$1,212,800 to Era Valdivia Contractors, Inc. at the January 3, 2023 Board meeting. The project will include the painting of the tank as well as repairs to the Standpipe's foundation some additional safety enhancements. The project is scheduled to begin (weather permitting) in April and be completed by August 2023. As the project requires the Standpipe to be drained, the Village of Hinsdale Water Department will be closely monitoring the water system while the Standpipe is out of service. The Village does not anticipate water service interruptions during this project but asks residents to be mindful of their water usage during this rehabilitation.

In addition to the work on the Standpipe, two temporary monopoles will be constructed onsite to house the telecommunication equipment that is located on top of the Village's Standpipe. The construction of these monopoles will occur in early spring 2023.
