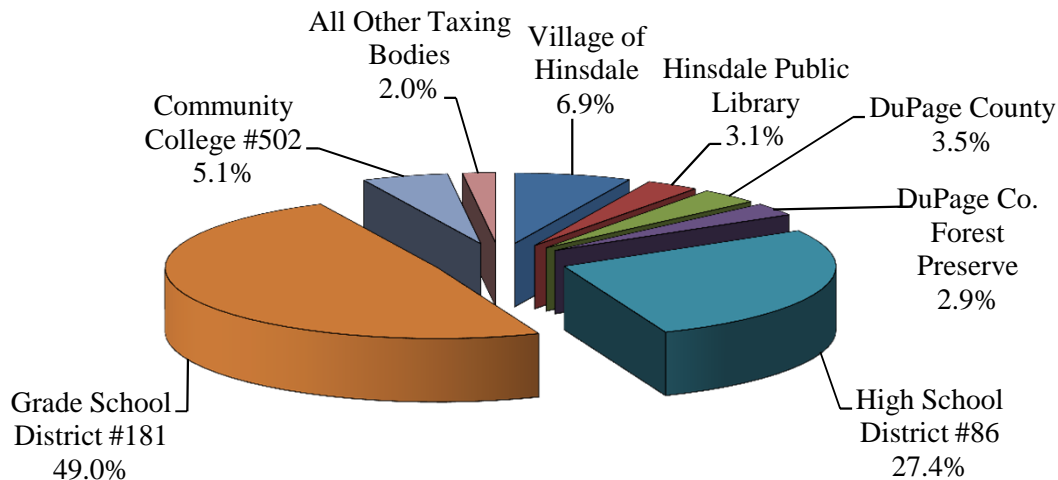


What Our Village of Hinsdale Property Taxes Support

Who Gets Our Property Tax Money?



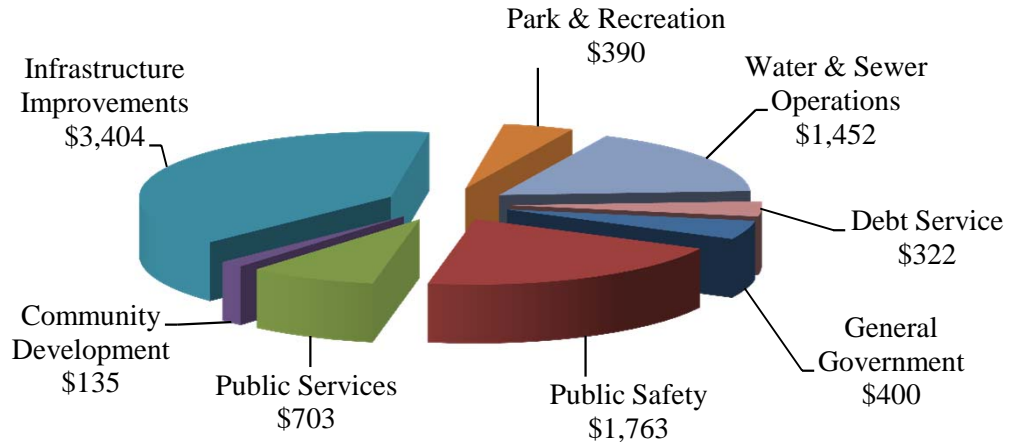

The distribution of tax dollars above uses the taxing agencies applicable to most Hinsdale residents. For Hinsdale residents living in other taxing agencies (e.g. Cook County), the Village's share of the overall tax bill remains about the same. The Village finances about 14.6% of its operations through property taxes. Per the 2010 Census, the Village has 5,361 occupied housing units.

Village of Hinsdale 2016 Budget Average Cost of Services Per Household



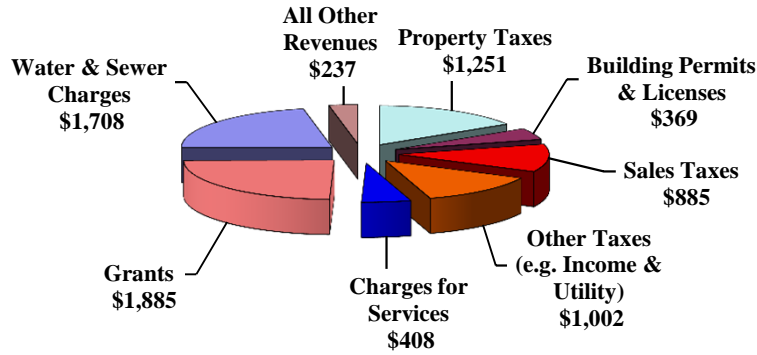

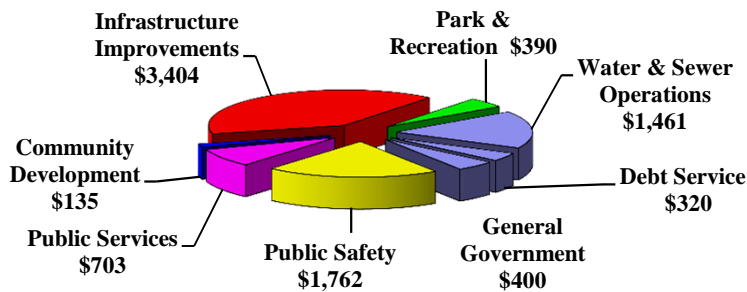
