<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Glass bottles or jars (all colors)</b></li><li>• <b>Aluminum cans or clean foil</b></li><li>• <b>Tin cans and empty aerosol cans</b></li><li>• <b>Plastic containers with the following numbers:</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- #1 PET bottles and containers</li><li>- #2 HDPE bottles and containers</li><li>- #3 PVC bottles</li><li>- #4 LDPE bottles and containers</li><li>- #5 PP plastic bottles and containers</li><li>- #7 plastic narrow neck grocery containers</li></ul></li><li>• <b>Six and twelve pack rings</b></li><li>• <b>Newspaper</b></li><li>• <b>Direct mail, bills and envelopes</b></li><li>• <b>Magazines and catalogs</b></li><li>• <b>Telephone directories</b></li><li>• <b>Office and school paper</b></li><li>• <b>Brown paper bags</b></li><li>• <b>Paperboard ands Chipboard (cereal boxes)</b></li><li>• <b>Wet strength cardboard (beverage cartons)</b></li><li>• <b>Corrugated cardboard (pieces &lt; 3'x3')</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Plastic bags and wrap</b></li><li>• <b>Motor oil, anti-freeze, pool chemical containers</b></li><li>• <b>Pesticide and herbicide containers</b></li><li>• <b>Window glass and mirrors</b></li><li>• <b>Food-contaminated paper or cardboard</b></li><li>• <b>Diapers</b></li><li>• <b>Tissue Paper</b></li><li>• <b>Automobile parts</b></li><li>• <b>Carpeting, roofing and siding materials</b></li><li>• <b>Toys</b></li><li>• <b>Buckets and gasoline cans</b></li><li>• <b>Hoses and pipes</b></li><li>• <b>Clothes hangers</b></li></ul> <p><i>Please rinse bottles and jars.
