EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a Declaration of Emergency has been executed pursuant to Chapter 11 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 11 of the City Code authorizes the Mayor to exercise certain exceptional powers due to an emergency, including the authority to govern the City by proclamation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH Chapter 11 of the City Code I, Carrie Tergin, Mayor, hereby proclaim the following:

- 1. All persons, businesses, and organizations within the City of Jefferson are hereby ordered to fully comply with the provisions of any order issued by the Director of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services relating to the prevention and spread of COVID-19.
- 2. Any violation of any order of the Director of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services relating to the prevention and spread of COVID-19 shall be considered a violation of this proclamation and an offense.
- 3. Any violation of this proclamation by any business or organization having a business license or liquor license issued by the City of Jefferson shall constitute grounds for suspension or revocation of such business license and/or liquor license.
- 4. The provisions of this proclamation shall be in effect immediately and remain in effect until removed by myself, the City Council, or by operation of ordinance.
