

# Push Carts



## Licenses needed:

- ✓ Business License
- ✓ Operating Permit

## Hours of Vending:

- There is no vending between the hours of 3:00am to 6:00am.



## To offload product:

- Vendors are allowed 10 minutes to offload their cart and equipment at the start of the vending day
- Vendors are allowed 10 minutes to load at the termination of the vending day.

## What do I need to operate my push cart?

- There are certain size requirements for a push cart.
  - Length Minimum of 40" Maximum of 72"
  - Width Minimum of 32" Maximum of 40"
  - Height Minimum of 36" Maximum of 72"

## Where can I vend?

- Pushcarts must be at least 20 feet from any other vendor, push cart or other business that sells food. \*\*\*\* This does not apply as part of a parade permit\*\*\*\*

## What equipment does my cart need?

- Handwashing sink with hot and cold water and paper towels, trash receptacle.
- Prefer to have a three compartment sink for washing
- Utensils ( Extra utensils will be needed, if the cart is not equipped with a triple sink)
- A potable water system
- A waste water holding system
- Adequate hot and cold storage
- Tight fitting lids for all containers
- Condiments in a single service portions

## Commissary Agreement:

- Vendors shall have an agreement with a food-handling establishment. This can be a restaurant, grocery store or convenience store.
- The agreement must be in writing.
- The document must be submitted along with the food operating application.
- The pushcart would return daily to this location for fresh water, dispose of gray water and restock with food items.
- This location should have a three compartment sink available to wash, rinse and sanitize all equipment, utensils and any other items used on the cart.
