



# DOG PARK RULES

**These rules are designed to promote the safety of you and your dog.**



The City of Lapeer is not liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog, or person.



Use of the dog park is at the risk of the owner. Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by their dogs.



Park hours are 6 a.m. - 10:30 p.m.



Close gates upon entering and exiting.



Dogs must be licensed and up to date on all shots. Only dogs that are healthy, fully immunized and dewormed may use this park.



Dogs must be accompanied by individuals 16 years or older. Owners must remain with their dogs, and dogs must be watched at all times.



Children 15 and under must be supervised by an adult.



No dogs under the age of 4 months.



Only 3 dogs per person allowed.



No dogs in heat.



It is the owner's responsibility to immediately clean up after your dog.



No food, drink, glass, alcohol, or treats allowed.



No digging (if your dog digs it, refill it).



Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed from the park.



Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the park.



Dog bites must be reported to Lapeer County Animal Control.



Report park maintenance issues to the Lapeer City Parks Department.



Violation of these rules will get you expelled from using the park or may result in a citation.
