**APPROVAL OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE LOUISVILLE-

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated 22 Stability Vouchers (SV) to the Louisville Metro Housing Authority (LMHA) with an ACC funding increment effective date of October 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires that any public housing agency receiving SVs enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the local Continuum of Care (CoC) for administration and the provision of supportive services; and

WHEREAS, the Louisville-Jefferson County CoC is the sole CoC operating in LMHA's jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISVILLE METRO HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that the Executive Director and Contracting Officer is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Louisville-Jefferson County Continuum of Care for Stability Voucher administration and the provision of supportive services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director is authorized, empowered, and directed to take any and all such related or ancillary actions necessary and appropriate to achieve the foregoing purpose as may be reasonably determined by the Executive Director.

#### I. STATEMENT OF FACTS:

The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116-260) (2021 Act), made available \$43,343,000 for new incremental voucher assistance under Section 8(o) of the United States Housing Act of 1937 for use by individuals and families experiencing or at-risk of homelessness; those fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking; and veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meets one of the proceeding criteria.

HUD has made 22 of these Stability Vouchers available to the Louisville Metro Housing Authority (LMHA).

In order to receive a voucher allocation, HUD requires that public housing agencies enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with their local Continuum of Care (CoC) to administer the Stability Vouchers.

As the Louisville-Jefferson County CoC is the sole CoC serving LMHA's jurisdiction, LMHA wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Louisville-Jefferson County CoC to administer the 22 Stability Vouchers.

#### II. ALTERNATIVES:

- A. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding with the Louisville-Jefferson County CoC for Stability Voucher administration and the provision of supportive services.
- B. Do not approve the Memorandum of Understanding.

#### III. RECOMMENDATION:
