Board of Commissioners Overview

The Louisville Metro Housing Authority (LMHA) Board of Commissioners is the nine-member policy making body of the agency. LMHA Commissioners are appointed by the Metro Mayor, with the approval of the Louisville Metro Council. Officers are elected by the Board of Commissioners each year at the July meeting.

State law requires that board members are at least 25 years of age and live within the city limits. Diverse in its composition, LMHA Board members include public housing residents, and there is sensitivity to race, gender, residency and professional background relative to appointments.

LMHA Executive Director, Elizabeth Strojan, serves as Secretary of the Board of Commissioners, but has no vote on policy matters. Board meetings are publicized and are open to the public.

The LMHA Board of Commissioners generally meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 3:30 p.m.
