

Louisville Metro Housing Authority Scholarship Application

Please submit all of the following information to the **Louisville Metro Housing Authority Scholarship Committee, 1411 Algonquin Parkway, Louisville, KY 40210**. Employees of LMHA are not eligible for consideration.

Deadline for application – Must be **postmarked** no later than **April 15, 2023**. Applications postmarked **after** April 15, 2023 will **not** be considered.

Applications that are incomplete or lack additional required attachments will not be considered.

High School seniors or students already attending a post-secondary program may apply.

Requirements for Scholarship application:

- Applicant must be a legal resident of a LMHA managed property or participate in the Section 8 Voucher Program for at least six (6) months and enrolled in an undergraduate program.
- Student must have maintained a 2.5 GPA (grade point average) (C+) or better during junior and senior years of high school or during college if already attending.
- Application must include:
 - School Transcript – most recent transcript from High School or GED or College if already attending.
 - An essay explaining why he/she wishes to continue their education (500 words or less).
 - List of schools to which the student has applied or is attending. Student must have made application as a full-time student to be eligible.
 - Description of applicant's extracurricular activities, awards, community service, employment and other accomplishments.
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation from clergy, teacher(s), counselor, property manager or landlord, case manager or employer. Letters must be signed and include contact information.

Proof of admission to college, university, business or vocational school as a full-time student and the school's financial award letter will be required at this time.

Scholarship Distribution:

The college, university, business or vocational school will administer the recipient's scholarship. Financial assistance will be based on need, not to exceed \$1,500. Scholarships are contingent upon funding availability. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled full-time. If a student is not full-time and/or does not maintain a 2.5 GPA, financial assistance may be withdrawn. Scholarship awards are for one year.
