

Public Act 102-0015 signed by the Governor on June 17, 2021 allows voters to complete a one-time application to become enrolled in a Permanent Vote by Mail program and receive a ballot by mail for all subsequent elections.

- ❖ Prior to this new law, voters requesting to vote by mail were required to **complete an application for ballot for each election.**
- ❖ Now, you may complete an **Application for Permanent Vote by Mail Status** and have a ballot ***automatically*** mailed to you at any address specified for all future elections.
- ❖ **A voter remains in a permanent status** until the voter requests to be removed, provides notice of a change of address outside of Madison County or our office receives confirmation that the voter has registered to vote in another county.
- ❖ Ballots are mailed 40 days prior to each election and we ask you to specify on the application where your ballot should be mailed if different from your registration address
