The meeting was called to order by Mike Babcock, Chair at 10:00 a.m.

The May 7, 2021 minutes were approved by all Health Department Committee Members present.

Purchase Order Recommendations: A motion was made by Mike Walters, and seconded by Aaron Messner to approve Madison County Health Department Committee Purchase Order Recommendations/Requests: AYES: Chris Guy, Michael Babcock, Terry Eaker, Mike Walters, Aaron Messner, Valerie Doucleff, and Jack Minner. Expense Reports: A motion was made by Mike Walters, and seconded by Terry Eaker, to approve the May 2021, Madison County Health Department Expense Summary Report. AYES: Chris Guy, Michael Babcock, Terry Eaker, Mike Walters, Aaron Messner, Valerie Doucleff, and Jack Minner. NAYS: None.

Resolution: A motion was made by Mike Walters and seconded by Aaron Messner to approve the "Revised Resolution to Purchase Fifty-Six Lenovo Laptop Computers for the Madison County Health Department". Motion carried unanimously.

Director Public Health Report: Vaccine Update – Pfizer vaccinations have become available to youth ages 12-15 years old. We have continued and will continue through the month of June to keep 6 days a week of clinics scheduled along with doing additional mobile clinics this week. Our mobile sites this month are located in Alton (Moose Lodge & Gordon Moore Park), Glen Carbon (American Legion), Venice (Library) and Wood River(VFW). We now are offering clinics at various schools throughout the County from 3:30-7:30 pm., at the following locations: Alton High School, Trimpe Middle School (Bethalto), Long Elementary (Madison), Collinsville High School and Middle School, Edwardsville Middle School (Liberty), Highland Primary School, Roxana (Rox Arena), Granite City High School, East Alton Middle School, and Triad High School. We also have several providers that are now offering the vaccine to their patients. To date, we have administered 4,116 doses to minors (12-17 y/o). Madison County is 23rd out of 102 counties in the State of Illinois to have at least 1 dose administered to our population. About 51% of eligible residents have received at least 1 dose of vaccine. Over 37% of our eligible Madison County Residents, are fully vaccinated.

We opened back up for our STD Clinic, School Physicals, and Well Women Visits for those who are enrolled in our IBCCP (Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer) Program. Staff are back out in the field conducting inspections.

The Annual Report for 2020 is complete.

New Business: A motion was made by Jack Minner and seconded it by Mike Walters to approve the "Amendment to County Ordinance 2020-07, Prohibiting The Use of Groundwater As A Potable Water Supply By The Installation or Use of Potable Water Supply Wells or by any Other Method".
