The meeting of the Madison County Health Department Committee of the County Board was held at the Madison County Administrative Bldg., Edwardsville, IL on October 4, 2019.

The meeting was called to order by Ray Wesley, Chair at 10:00 a.m.

A motion was made by Chrissy Dutton, seconded by Michael Holliday Sr., to approve the minutes of the September 6, 2019 meeting. Motion approved unanimously.

Public Health Administrator Report: Gave an overview of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program and the upcoming Full Scale Exercise the Health Department is participating in October 1-10, 2019.

Respiratory Illnesses associated with E-Cigarettes and Vaping update: As of October 3, 2019, 138 cases have been reported in the state of Illinois. Madison County has had 1 reported case, the median age is 22, range 13-56 years of age. Communicable Disease investigation case. A case has been identified in Madison County associated with a nationwide Salmonella outbreak involving turtles. Health department staff will collect environmental samples from a pet turtle for the same Salmonella organism at the request of IDPH and CDC.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. Our nurses have scheduled several community screening events and outreach activities.

Still working on the proposed County FY2020 Health Department budget.

New Business: Vaping issue and the need for a county wide ordinance for every school. Toni to follow up. Dr. Kugler provided clippings of articles in reference to the Vaping Epidemic. Phil Chapman thanked the experts on the Health Advisory Committee for sharing their information.

Mr. Holliday shared information on:
NACCHO, with support from CDC, is offering year 2 of a technical assistance opportunity titled Strong Systems, Stronger Communities TA Cohorts for local health departments. The initiative provides support to health departments in completing projects to improve their performance, meet national accreditation standards, and promote interconnection across the public health system to improved population health. An overview webinar will be on Tuesday, October 8, 2019, 3:30-4:30 pm ET.

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Amended Inmate Medicaid Exclusion Policies. Want to get this turned over so the people in jail will still get the benefits in health that they need.

Resolution – Stepping Up. This initiative is to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in jail.


Congratulations to Toni for receiving the Kathleen Quinn award, an award honoring her activism in working for victims of abuse and neglect!
