We are writing for a new grant through IDPH, "Local Health Department Overdoses Surveillance & Response". It is a 3 year grant. The application is due on November 12, 2021.

Reviewed the Madison County Health Department Summary (handout) through September 30, 2021 activities report and the last 3 years perspective.

COVID Boosters have now been approved for Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson.

- Pfizer vaccine booster– 6 months after 2nd dose of series.
- Moderna vaccine booster- 6 months after 2nd dose of series.
- Johnson & Johnson booster – 2 months after vaccination.

Vaccination Clinics. Today we have a COVID Pfizer Vaccine clinic at SIUE. Pediatric doses (Pfizer only) has now been approved and our first clinic will be Wednesday, November 10, 2021. We are having clinics on


