The meeting of the Madison County Health Department Committee of the County Board was held at the Madison County Administrative Bldg., Edwardsville, IL on July 2, 2021.

The meeting was called to order by Mike Babcock, Chair at 10:00 a.m.

The June 4, 2021 minutes were approved by all Health Department Committee Members present.

Public Comment: None

Purchase Order Recommendations: A motion was made by Chris Guy, and seconded by Mike Walters to approve Madison County Health Department Committee Purchase Order Recommendations/Requests: Facebook Posts for COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics May-August 2021, not to exceed \$15,000; Reimbursement for Purchase of Narcan, \$9,000. Director Public Health Report: FY 2020 Annual Report distributed, reviewed and questions answered.

Vaccine Update – July 3 is the last day for the Mass Vaccination Clinic at Gateway, Collinsville IL. Gave an overview of Madison County Vaccine Data. As of June 30, 2021, 52.24% of Madison County residents have received at least 1 dose, 41.79% (110,523) of Madison County residents are fully vaccinated, totaling 213,285 vaccines given in Madison County. We have conducted 223 vaccination clinics at various locations in Madison County with the maximum throughput of over 3,000 per day from 12/31/2020 to 6/30/2021. Staff at vaccine site included: 95 Illinois National Guard, 5 MVAT Teams (19 per team), 1 CVAT Team (20 per team), 35 Madison County Health Department Employees, and 124 Medical Reserve Corps Volunteers. Currently, we still have 20 Guardsmen still helping.

The Delta Variant has been identified in every state in the U.S. We are definitely seeing an uptake in cases. We need to continue to encourage people who are not vaccinated to become vaccinated. Discussion.

New Business: A motion was made by Terry Eaker and seconded by Mike Walters to approve the resolution “Postponing Late Fees for Annual Renewal of Food Permits with Expiration Dates Prior to October 1, 2021 Pursuant To Chapter 55 Madison County Food Sanitation Ordinance”. Motion carried unanimously.
