MEETING MINUTES

The meeting of the Madison County Health Department Committee of the County Board was held at the Madison County Administrative Bldg., Edwardsville, IL on September 6, 2019.

The meeting was called to order by Ray Wesley, Chair at 10:00 a.m.

A motion was made by Michael Holliday Sr., seconded by Jack Minner, to approve the minutes of the August 2, 2019 meeting. Motion approved unanimously.

Resolutions: A motion was made by Phil Chapman and seconded by Michael Holliday Sr. to approve three (3) resolutions to purchase various vaccines from Merck Sharp & Dohme Corp., Glaxo Smith Kline, and Sanofi Pasteur. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Health Administrator Report: Respiratory Illnesses associated with E-Cigarettes and Vaping: As of September 5, 2019, 42 cases have been reported in the state of Illinois. Madison County has had 1 reported case. Out of the 42 cases, 24 have been interviewed, 17 reported vaping THC, 41 were admitted to hospital, 26 were in ICU, 14 were intubated. 
New Business: Michael Holliday Sr. gave an overview of the sessions he attended at the NALBOH 2019 Conference, Denver, CO.
