Public Health Administrator's Report: Illinois HIV Planning Group puts out a newsletter quarterly and the Madison County Health Department Nurses are being recognized for their work in the HIV program.

This week is National Public Health Week, April 3-9, 2017. Media release has been sent out.

Several businesses who have failed to renew operating permits (5-food service, 2-body art and 1-tanning delinquent facilities) have been sent to States Attorney's office to initiate prosecution. Petitions will be filed with the Court to close delinquent facilities until the permit is paid up to date.

Health Department has a new Nurse Practitioner, Chontay McKay and our STD Clinic is operating on Tuesdays again.

Job openings have been posted for one full-time, one part-time Staff Nurse, and one full-time Sanitarian at the Health Department.

Mary Cooper is retiring on April 28, 2017 and Erin Boester will be the Interim Director of Health Protection until the position is permanently filled.

Partnership for Drug-Free Communities Coalition – Jean reported of a discussion that the Administrations is considering stopping detox medication for those coming into jail. After some research, found out that a 4-day detox (which is the first step to treatment) is \$6.48. Approximately 10-20 people per day are brought into the jail and about half of them need detox. Conversations about paying the \$6.48 versus a \$5,000-7,000 emergency room fee if the individual would need it from not receiving the detox medications and having a bad reaction. Chestnut is willing to set up a program with the jail that they will take the clients and give them the Vivitrol that will help keep them clean until they can get treatment.
