ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The meeting of the Madison County Board of Health Advisory Committee was held at the Madison County Health Department on May 4, 2017.

The meeting was called to order by Dorothy Droste, Chair at 5:02 p.m.

**Public Health Administrator's Report:** Illinois Food Code Training Presentations – Having good attendance. Getting positive feedback.

Health Department Committee meeting has been changed from 10:30 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. due to continuing conflict of the Finance Committee running longer.

Lonnie Silveus was hired to fill the Sanitarian position. He will start on May 22, 2017.

Mary Cooper has retired and Erin Boester, Interim Director of Health Protections, has handled multiple situations very well this week.

We are looking into participating in the Liquor Compliance Inspection project (LC-13), providing Field Inspections for approximately 337 local liquor retailers. MCHD will be paid \$75.00 per inspection to verify compliance with local ordinances, general sanitation of the premises, and report violations to IL Liquor Commission. The LC-13 program will be incorporated into existing inspection schedules of Health Department Inspectors and Sanitarians.

Job openings still posted are one full-time, one part-time Staff Nurse.

Flood update – Health Department has been working closely with the City of Alton and the Emergency Operations Center. There was one shelter in Granite City that was open. Only one restaurant in Alton was closed due to floodwaters.

Toni has been nominated to be President-Elect of Illinois Public Health Association. The position begins on July 1, 2017. The IPHA Annual Meeting will be in Springfield, IL, September 19-21, 2017. Illinois has the largest affiliate of the American Public Health Association in the United States.

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QI Project – Two quarters of data has been collected thus far in the current Quality Improvement project. The data is being collected to determine the flow and the amount of time it takes, from signing in to when the patient leaves the health clinic. Two quarters is showing an average clinic visit to be 1 hour 7 minutes long. An average of 30-36 clients visit the clinic each day. Once this project is completed, data will be utilized to increase efficiencies within the clinic.

HIV outreach grant received funding to provide outreach, education and awareness. Ads were purchased on the Grindr social media app. In February and March. Data indicated that our ads received 954 views in February and 851 views in March. Since ad stopped, only 9 views have been recorded. We intend to purchase 6 months of ads with grant funding to continue outreach activities.

PrEP (Pre-exposure prophylaxis program) is for individuals at high risk for contracting HIV. The health department offers PrEP to clients who meet the criteria. IDPH visited MCHD several weeks ago to showcase our program with other local health departments who want to initiate PrEP in their clinics.

**MCPCH:** Mental Health Alliance – May is Mental Health Awareness Month. Next meeting is scheduled for June 16, 2017 from 10:30 a.m. – Noon at Alton Memorial Hospital.

Partnership for Drug Free Communities Coalition – On May 24, 2017, in place of the meeting, they have a speaker to talk about marijuana and the negative impact of legalizing marijuana has had in her Colorado community. Location at Anderson Hospital.

Air Quality – Meeting was this afternoon and planning for the fall forum “Keep It Local” is progressing. Several speakers have been scheduled. Next meeting is June 1, 2017, 2:30 p.m. at Metro East Park/Recreation Dept., Collinsville.

QuitGuide is a free app that helps you understand your smoking patterns and build the skills needed to become and stay smoke free. New to QuitGuide in 2016 is the ability to track cravings by time of day and location. Get inspirational messages for each craving you track, which keep you focused and motivated on your smoke free journey.
