ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The meeting of the Madison County Board of Health Advisory Committee was held at the Madison County Health Department on February 6, 2020.

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m.

A motion was made by Rebecca Dunn Bradley and seconded by Dorothy Droste to approve the January 2, 2020 meeting minutes. Motion Approved.

Public Comment/Announcements: Welcomed Dr. Weber, M.D. to the Health Advisory Committee and gave a brief overview of the duties of this committee.

Jean reported on a webinar referencing substance abuse issues related to the use of peer counselors across the nation. Peer counselors are working with people that come into the emergency room or hospital who have a substance abuse issue and try to get them into recovery. Ty Beckel from Alton Memorial was one of the speakers.

New Business: The proposed amendments to the Madison County Body Art Ordinance were discussed with Health Advisory Committee members. This will be on the Board of Health meeting agenda for approval in March.

Public Health Administrator's Report: Two Purchasing requests will be presented to Health Department Committee for approval. Influenza vaccine for FY2020 and Shingrix vaccine from FFF.

Novel Coronavirus 2019 Update – The health department is working together with IDPH and CDC to monitor updates and keeping current on guidelines. As of today there has been 47 people tested, 19 pending results, 26 negative, 2 positive cases in the State of Illinois. The Health Department will enter into a consultant agreement with Jersey County Health Department to assist with the transition of the Private Sewage Disposal System Program from Madison County Planning and Development Department to the Health Department. Target date is May 1, 2020.

Cancer Committee – Next meeting scheduled March 18, 2020, 9:30am at Health Department.


Partnership for Drug Free Communities Coalition – Received the Madison County 2019 overdose deaths by Drug and Fentanyl was the leading drug. Vaping and Substance use Community Awareness Night, March 10, 2020, 6:30 pm, Webster Elementary School, Collinsville, IL. The next PDFC meeting is on February 26, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. at Anderson Hospital.

Dr. McGranahan: Vaping associated lung injuries statistics from CDC as of January 28, 2020 is 60 deaths nationwide, almost 2800 admissions into the hospital. Three quarters of the cases are associated with the Vitamin E acetate or THC products. Median age admitted is 24, median age of deaths is 51.

Federal regulations for banning various brands and flavors goes into effect next week. This only applies to vaping pens that have refillable cartridges. Researchers warn that some young people have already moved on to the disposable e-cigarettes that are not included in the flavor ban.
