Public Health Administrator's Report: Distributed a written Health Advisory Committee Report for February 8, 2022 which provided a COVID Update. In summary, the entire State of Illinois remains in High Transmission (High is >100 cases per 100,000). Case rate continues to decline, February 7, 2022 538.85 from February 1, 2022 it was 1,150.72; 2,356 cases January 25-31, 2022 and 985 cases February 2-7, 2022.

COVID-19 Vaccination Booster and Clinic Information - MCHD is planning for roll out of Under 5 years old Pfizer vaccine. Waiting for ACIP and CDC approval. It will be a 2-dose series 3 mcg dose 21 days apart for 6 month to 2-year olds. Three dose series may be recommended for 2-4 years olds. All to be determined at a later date. Pharmacies can only vaccinate children down to age 3.

Moderna vaccine was fully approved by FDA and available at Madison County Health Department on Mondays.

LHD Overdoses Surveillance & Response Grant – MCHD was awarded this grant from IDPH in the amount of \$62,500. Three-year grant term. This grant will support MCHD in the development of local response plans for opioid overdose and associated morbidity and mortality.


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Unfinished Business: None.
