Partnership for Drug Free Communities Coalition – Executive Order Strengthening the States commitment to ending the Opioid Epidemic (handed out with packet). 2018 data from the IDPH shows a 21.6% reduction from the 2020 projected number of fatal opioid overdoses. The non-fatal overdoses have increased. Evidenced-based policies and programs need to be prioritized in order to increase access to treatment and to reduce risk of overdoses.
