

Environmental Grants Program



About

The Environmental Grant Program provides reimbursement funding to units of local government for solid waste management, air quality initiatives, energy efficiencies, smart growth, and stormwater projects, with a goal of promoting best management practices within Madison County.

Grants of up to \$15,000 are awarded to qualifying projects with the following conditions:

- Twenty percent (20%) matching funds are provided by the applicant
 - In-kind funds (transportation, mileage, labor) are permitted
- Project must be paid for prior to requesting reimbursement
- Local government provides a resolution of support
- Letters of support are strongly encouraged, but not required
- Equipment purchases require up to three (3) bids

Ineligible projects include:

- Recreation equipment, transportation, mileage, labor, education, disposal fees, tractors and/or wheeled vehicles, generators powered by gas, diesel, or propane unless upgrading to more efficient models
