

Local Workforce Area 22 – Youth Competitive Procurement Policy

Effective July 1, 2016

Local policies and procedures for procurement of youth providers will be in accordance with Section 123 of the Act. The Youth Committee may recommend eligible providers of youth activities based on knowledge of existing youth programs or by utilizing a youth needs analysis. This analysis identifies providers in the Madison/Bond County area who provide services based on one or more of the fourteen essential elements. The WIB will select the eligible providers recommended and award grants or contracts on a competitive basis every other year through a request for proposal process (RFP). The WIB in conjunction with the CEO, Youth Committee and Madison County Employment and Training Department also has reserved the right to renew contracts every other year based on performance as recommended for renewal by the Madison County Employment and Training Department and the Madison-Bond Youth Committee.
