A brief discussion was held on where the team will store the trailer and it will ultimately be TBD.

1. Chairman Bogard discussed the recently held CAMEO class the he attended in Fairview Heights. He said it was very beneficial, especially in identifying the hazardous materials in our County and their locations.

Team Leader Report

29 September 2022

Operations

8/19/2022 – Team Activation (Confined Space Recovery)

- Edwardsville Fire Department was called for a worker in a manhole. Arrived to find the Father of the victim at the top of a manhole who had previously tried to make access to the patient but was overcome. The first arriving police officer also tried to make access to the victim but was overcome. EFD personnel made entry into the hole on air to assess the victim. While assessing the patient, a second victim was found in the hole. It was determined that rescue efforts were futile and the operation was changed to a recovery effort. Madison County TRT was requested and the victims were successfully recovered. The cause of the incident was found to be an Oxygen deficient atmosphere with initial readings around 10%. No Madison County TRT injuries or equipment damages were reported.
