ITEM II STATISTICS REPORT

Chief Petruch presented the Monthly Statistical Report for March 2014. The Chief of Police stated 115 state accidents were reported, 824 citations were written, and Calls for Service 1,714 were responded to. Chief stated False Alarms were high at 206 due to the severe weather, and 37 citations were issued due to false alarms. No homicides or rapes reported. Residential burglaries held steady at 16.
