COMMERCE ROAD PEDESTRIAN PROJECT

The Downtown Development Authority is partnering with the Village to split the east and westbound lanes on either side of the center stanchion to provide

traffic calming and most importantly to allow pedestrian access on the north side of Commerce which will link to 100 additional parking spaces.

The project is expected to be completed Fall 2022.







WATER METER REPLACEMENT PROGRAM - HYDROCORP

Starting in the Fall of 2022, the Village of Milford will be contracting with HydroCorp to change all water meters in the Village. Additionally, HydroCorp will be conducting a water safety survey that involves a cross-connection

survey, a sump pump discharge survey, and documentation of the water service material.

Letters informing residents or property owners that they are able to schedule an appointment to have their meter replaced started going out in September 2022 and will continue through the spring of 2023.

All appointments must be scheduled through HydroCorp, not the Village.

NEW POLICE CHIEF

Following an extensive search and selection process, we are pleased to announce that *Milford Police Lieutenant Scott Tarasiewicz* was appointed to serve as the Milford Police Chief, effective July 1, 2022.

Chief Tarasiewicz has served the community as a member of the Milford Police Department for 23 years as a Patrol Officer, Detective, Sergeant, and most recently as the Patrol Operations Lieutenant. In addition to his law enforcement efforts, Lt. Tarasiewicz has been an active member of the community through his work with the Village Elves, Pigs 4 Wigs, the Special Olympics, and a number of other organizations.





DOG LICENSES

2023 Dog licenses will be available for purchase at the Township Offices and on the WEBSITE (milfordtownship. com) starting December 2022. Current prices are \$25.00 for an unaltered animal or \$15.00 if the pet has been



spayed or neutered. Seniors 65 years of age or older are discounted to \$14.00 for a spayed or neutered pet or \$23.00 for an unaltered pet. These prices are good through June 1st 2023 – after that date all licenses are considered delinquent and the cost is \$40.00.

Pets with adoption papers dated past the June 1st deadline or puppies too young to have received a rabies vaccination before June 1st will be licensed using the current prices. Proof of the adoption or change of ownership is required.

ASSESSMENT REMINDER ...

Assessment Change notices will be arriving in your mailbox the third week of FEBRUARY 2023. It is very important that you review it carefully. If the address on the notice is your PRIMARY RESIDENCE please make sure that it is listed as 100% PRE.

These new numbers will affect your 2023 taxes. If you disagree with the new assessment there is information on the notice on how to appeal the assessment.

2022 WINTER TAX BILLS

Winter tax statements will be mailed November 30, 2022 and are DUE December 1, 2022 with a grace period through February 14, 2023. All payments received on February 14, 2023 will be received as "on time".

A 3% penalty will be added on February 15, 2023 for all taxes not received in the Treasurers office. Payments made after February 14th must be received by the treasurer on or before February 28, 2023.

POST MARKS WILL NOT BE HONORED.



TOWNSHIP ROADS

All roads (excluding Village of Milford roads) within the Township are owned and maintained by Oakland County. Hazardous conditions on the roads (such as potholes, grading or plowing) should be reported directly to the Road Commission for Oakland County at www.rcocweb.org or 248-858-4804.



TRASH PICK UP TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

GFL is closed six days yearly on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Fourth of July
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day.

If your pickup day falls on or after a holiday during the business week, services will be ONE DAY LATER.



PAYMENTS MAILED VIA USPS

Tax payments that are mailed through the United States Postal Service are not guaranteed to be delivered to the treasurers' office ON TIME. If you are mailing your tax payment please DO NOT wait until the last week to put it in the mail. It is suggested that you give at least three (3) weeks or more for timely posting. Better yet, if possible, drop your payment in the drop box to be sure that it is received on time. Please call our offices to be sure that we received mailed tax payments. Also, PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR BANK or balance your checkbook to make sure that the payment was cashed. Failure to do either of the above does not waive interest or pentalties on tax payments received after the due date

TOWNSHIP BURN PERMITS

In order to open burn in Milford Township a permit must first be obtained from Milford Township Offices 248-685-8731 before burning. A permit number will be issued and either mailed or emailed to you with a copy of the ordinance. The permit DOES NOT EXPIRE. Each time you burn you still need to call the Milford Police Department 248-684-1815 with the burn permit number that was assigned by Milford Township. The ordinance is also available on the Milford Township Website (www. milfordtownship.com).

Open burning is allowed in MILFORD TOWNSHIP ONLY.

SEWER CREDITS

If you are a Village resident and water outside and do not have a separate meter for irrigation you may qualify for a watering credit. Applications are available online at www.villageofmilford.org/forms.

Reminder, credits are not reviewed until after you receive your bill starting in September.

FINANCIAL TRANSPARENCY

Each year Milford Township and the Village of Milford must meet certain requirements to qualify for the full CVT Revenue Sharing payment from the State of Michigan. One of the requirements is that documents be made available to the public for viewing.
