- Information on healthy eating during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- Help with starting or continuing breastfeeding
- Infant formula, if needed

## ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

- Licensing and inspection for retail food facilities, public pools and water attractions, lodging, campgrounds, manufactured home communities, and tattoo and body piercing facilities.
- Sampling, testing, and inspecting
   of wells at establishments that
   provide drinking water to the public
   such as restaurants, bars, churches,
   and parks.
- Radon consultation and test kits.
- A water laboratory for drinking water testing for bacteria, nitrate, and arsenic.
- County residents with a private well (not city water) and a newborn in the home qualify for a free water sample test kit.



• **Free, voluntary services** for expectant parents and parents of children ages 0 to 5.

- Prenatal Services:
  - Monthly meetings or home visits with a Public Health Nurse
  - Education on the importance of prenatal care; nutrition; and avoidance of tobacco, alcohol, and other drug use
  - Information on fetal development,
     labor and delivery, and infant care
  - Assistance with finding health care
  - Postpartum support
  - Connections to additional community resources
- Birth to 5 Services:
  - Monthly meetings or home visits with a trained home visitor
  - Information and support to strengthen the parent-child relationship and improve family health and safety
  - Education on child development
  - Links to additional community resources
  - Social groups and parenting classes

NURSING SERVICES

Child and adult immunizations for protection from many infectious

diseases.

- Communicable disease prevention, detection, and control through community education, disease surveillance, and outbreak response.
- STI testing (Hepatitis C, gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis)
- HIV testing and counseling
- **3-month supply** of oral contraceptives or Depo-Provera
- Latex condoms and personal lubricant
- Emergency contraception (Plan B)
- Enrollment assistance in Family Planning Only Services (FPOS)
- All services are confidential, not limited by county residence and offered on a sliding fee scale.
