PRESS RELEASE

On May 24th, 2014, at approx. 5:27 pm New London Officers were dispatched to a fight in progress behind 633 Wallace St. It was reported that one of the subjects had a gun. Officers located a subject walking away from the scene, he was sweating and had blood on his hands and pants. Subject was identified as

Eric G. Parker, 20 years old from New London

Parker was in possession of an unloaded gun in his waistband. Parker was taken into custody. Parker was being uncooperative and appeared to be intoxicated. The gun was a 45 caliber and did not have a magazine in it and was unloaded.

Parker said he got involved in a fight after seeing Jamal Pointer strike a female. Parker said he pistol whipped Pointer in the head and a fight ensued. The other subject was identified as

Jamal A. Pointer, 19years old from New London

Pointer had visible head wound and was bleeding from the head. Pointer was currently out on a Signature bond through Waupaca County for a prior Battery.

Pointer is being referred to the DA on charges of: Disorderly Conduct and Felony Bail Jumping.

Parker is being referred to the DA on charges of: Possession of Drug paraphernalia, Endangering Safety by use of Dangerous Weapon while intoxicated, Carrying concealed weapon, substantial battery and Disorderly Conduct.

Both subjects were transported to Outagamie county Jail after being treated for injuries.

There is no further information at this time until the criminal complaint is issued.
