

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 13, 2006

A regular and open meeting of the City of New London Common Council was held on Tuesday, June 13, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building. After the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called. Presiding: Mayor Toltzman

AGENDA: Henke/Tate to adopt agenda as distributed. Carried 10-0.

MINUTES: Heise/Way to approve minutes of May 9, 2006 as written. Carried 10-0.

BILLS: Romberg/Morack to approve the paying of invoices incurred during May 2006 in the amount of \$437,624.46. Carried 10-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Dan Handschke asked the City to carefully consider the impact of a proposed well in the Town of Mukwa on the wetlands. He asked that the City meet with the Mukwa Wildlife Committee, on which he serves, and the Town Board. Mayor Toltzman assured him that the City would be following up on this and reminded him that development of this well site was probably twenty years out.

Kevin Peterson, a candidate for the 40th Assembly seat being vacated by Jean Hundertmark introduced himself, spoke of his qualifications and asked for support in the upcoming September Primary Election.

At 7:10 p.m. a Public Hearing was held on the proposed zoning code ordinance changes which would 1) Regulate structures of over 60,000 sq. feet; and 2) Amend specific ground sign requirements. Ken Rehbein addressed the Council on the former asking that the City do nothing to limit commercial development, as large retailers bring in many jobs and are beneficial to local charities. Mayor Toltzman explained that the proposed ordinance was not designed to keep anyone out but to protect the public so that adequate planning could be in place when large structures are built or abandoned. There being no other participants, hearing closed at 7:15 p.m.

1. Minutes of 5/25/06 were read by Henke.
2. Henke/Heise to waive the rules and adopt Ordinance No. 1153 upon one reading. Carried 10-0. Henke/Morack to adopt Ordinance No. 1153, which authorizes placement of one additional ground sign under certain circumstances. Carried 10-0. Ordinance No. 1153 is published separately and printed in the Ordinance Book.
3. Henke/Betts to accept the first reading of an ordinance establishing design requirements for retail development exceeding 60,000 square feet. There followed much discussion over specific requirements of this ordinance. Attention focused over some of the information a Retailer was expected to provide. Backers of the ordinance thought that more information was needed to properly judge the impact of the new building upon the City as a whole, rather than just the affected neighborhoods.

Others agreed that the information wasn't relevant and would be burdensome to acquire. Carried 6-5. Mayor Toltzman breaking the tie; (Kopitzke, Tate, O'Connell, Herter and Romberg against).
