<u>Request for sign variances- Valley Family Medicine</u>: We've had a request from Family Medicine to install a second sign at their location at 1505 Mill Street. They have an existing sign already on the corner, but would like to install a second sign with digital display. The proposal has a few conflicts with existing ordinances that the property owner is asking to consider variances for:

1) Allow the existing sign to remain in the Right of Way: 17.09-11 (2) states:

Setbacks and Other Yards: No portion of any sign other than those permitted as accessory uses to residences shall be permitted closer than 5 feet to the street right of way line, than the required minimum other property line, than the required minimum offsets of the district regulations. Ground signs may be permitted as close as 5 feet to the street line. (see Vision Corners 17.03-4(2).)

The existing sign is within the Right of Way. The property owner is requesting to allow this nonconforming sign to remain.

2) <u>Allow a second (digital messaging) sign to be installed on the premises</u>: 17.09-12 (1)(C) states:

One ground sign may be allowed for each premises within a Business District. One additional free standing ground sign may be permitted for a premise which is located at an intersection of two major streets, and which premise has a minimum of 400 feet of frontage. The ground signs must be placed a minimum of 200 feet apart measured between signs along the frontage.

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The initial proposed location from the existing sign would be about 100 feet, the "other" proposed location would be just on the south east side of their driveway on Mill Street at a distance of about 175 feet from their existing sign. They are asking for a variance from section 17.09-12(1)(C) to place the two signs within the 200 foot distance on their property (which has a frontage of about 335 feet). Included are some drawings provided from the sign vendor.


