Chairman Nuzzolillo called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Chairman Nuzzolillo welcomed all commissioners to the meeting via telephone; he then led the attendees in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Nuzzolillo on behalf of the Board of Fire Commission with a deep appreciation wished to thank all the Town Officials, Emergency Management Director and Fire Chief Paul Januszewski and the CERT Team to name a few.
