Further that the appointment was conditional that Runlett successfully passed a polygraph, psychological exam, medical exam and drug screen, and in-depth background investigation. In the event that Runlett was unavailable for the position, or if he did not successfully meet these conditions, Commissioner Hannon asked that the same offer be made to the remaining candidate; Dennis Ryan and Steven Crowley, in that specific order.

Commissioner Mead seconded this motion and all were in favor.

At 3:55 P.M., Commissioner made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Calafiore, and all were in favor.
