1. Call to Order
2. To consider and act upon a call for the Annual Budget Town Meeting:

The Board of Selectmen do hereby call for the Annual Budget Town Meeting to be held on Monday, May 10, 2021, at 7:00 pm in the auditorium of the North Haven High School, 221 Elm Street, North Haven, CT, with masks and distancing required, to conduct the following business:

- 1) To consider and act upon the recommendation of the Board of Finance to take action regarding the budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022;

- 2) To establish the due date and number of installments for the payment of property taxes (*Real Estate, Personal Property, Motor Vehicle and Supplemental Motor Vehicle*) in accordance with Sections 12-142 and 12-144a of the Connecticut General Statutes; and
- 3) Pursuant to Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes, to adjourn said town meeting at its conclusion and to submit the question concerning the adoption of a budget for fiscal year July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 to a vote by paper ballot on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, including the establishment of the exact hours of voting at REFERENDUM, pursuant to C.G.S. § 7-9b, that voting will take place between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. at the following North Haven polling place:
  - *ALL DISTRICTS: Mildred Wakeley Rec. Center, 7 Linsley Street*

The aforesaid recommendations will be placed on paper ballots as the following question: *“Shall the Town of North Haven, in accordance with the recommendation of the Board of Finance, approve and adopt a budget consisting of \$53,383,064 for the Town Government and \$58,470,730 for the Board of Education, for a total amount of \$111,853,794 for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022?”* Voters approving said question will vote “YES” and those opposing said question will vote “NO”.

### 3. Adjournment
