Resolutions for Special Town Meeting, Monday, March 25th, 2019

- a) **RESOLVED:** That in accordance with the recommendation of the Town Engineer, the following road is deemed accepted as a road of the Town of North Haven: Winding Brook Road.

- b) **RESOLVED:** That in accordance with the recommendation of the Board of Finance, an amendment to Section 32-9 of Article V of the Finances Ordinance is hereby approved and adopted at Chapter 32 of the Ordinances of the Town of North Haven to increase the value of contracts requiring public bid as authorized by Town Charter Section 406A from \$7,500 to \$25,000. The amendment to Section 32-9 of Article V of the Finances Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper having a circulation in the Town of North Haven and shall be effective fifteen (15) days after publication. All other terms and provisions of Section 32-9 remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Article V. Sealed Public Bids for Certain Contracts and Purchases

[Adopted 3-16-2009 STM]

§ 32-9 Increase in value of contracts requiring public bid as authorized by Town Charter Section 406A.

Except as otherwise required by any provision of the Connecticut General Statutes, contracts for the purchases of personal property or for services for the Town and/or Board of Education having a value in excess of ~~\$7,500~~25,000 shall be let by sealed, public bid by the First Selectman or the Board of Education, as the case may be. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, public bidding shall not be required for the services of attorneys at law, certified public accountants, licensed engineers, architects, physicians or dentists.
