

MINUTES

TOWN OF NORTH HAVEN NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING PROGRAMS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONNECTICUT NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT TUESDAY, JULY 14, 2020 AT 5:00 PM HELD VIA ZOOM VIDEOCONFERENCE AND CONFERENCE CALL

The Town Clerk, J. Stacey Yarbrough, opened the public hearing at 5:05 P.M., and introduced herself, as well as explaining the circumstances of it being a Zoom meeting, and the need to mute sound/phones, etc., as well as other procedure/guidelines to conduct the meeting. She also noted that Attorney Jennifer Coppola, the Zoom Hostess, would be in charge of listing the names of anyone who would like to comment, ask questions, and/or vote, for the evening's proceedings.

Further, the Town stated the purpose of the public hearing and read the Notice of Public Hearing into the record: After proper notice given, we are here this evening for the purpose of considering the following program that has been submitted for approval by the North Haven Town Meeting in accordance with the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act -- CNAA (C.G.S. §§12-630aa to 12-638): Continuing Energy Conservation Improvements for Moriarty Hall submitted by Lancraft Fife and Drum Corps.

Moreover, the Town Clerk advised those participating of the Special Town Meeting to be held immediately following this Public Hearing, but not earlier than 5:30 P.M.

Valerie Goodkin, executive assistant to the First Selectman Michael J. Freda, gave a brief explanation as relates to the Public Hearing participant for the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act, as well as information relating to the CNAA itself.

After Mrs. Goodkin's presentation, the Town Clerk opened the public hearing to public comment: Selectman William "Bill" Pieper offered comment as relates to the law and the applicant.

At the end of public comment, the Town Clerk noted her intention to adjourn the Public Hearing, and noted that she would make minutes of the hearing available as soon as possible. The public hearing was adjourned at 5:12 p.m.
