This program is run on a **DROP- IN BASIS** offering children the opportunity to interact with others in various recreational activities. Each child must be signed in and out daily by their parent/guardian unless written permission is given directly to the site director indicating the name of the person that will be signing that child out. Children will not be allowed to sign themselves in or out unless it is indicated and signed on the health waiver by that child's parent/guardian.
