Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980 as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of Orchard Lake Village. All installation shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the City of Orchard Lake Village with 24 (twenty-four) hour notice. The inspector will need the job location and the permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested or conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.
