

**CEDAR TOWNSHIP  
MINUTES  
March 15, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at Cedar Township Hall at 7:00 p.m., 9115 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Reed City, Michigan. Board members present: Supervisor Loren Stieg, Treasurer Heather Battle, Clerk Shirley Apsey, Deputy Clerk Cindy Gadbois, and Trustee Mary Clark and Trustee Ed Lundborg. Absent was Deputy Treasurer Jean Schember. Also, present was Assessor James Nienhuis.

Supervisor calls meeting to order. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

- **Motion** to approve February 15, 2022 meeting minutes as presented made by Heather and seconded by Mary as presented. All members voting yes.
- Treasurer's Report presented by Heather; accepted by Cindy, seconded by Ed. Report placed on file.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Renewal Proposal for township operations:

● **MOTION** to place the Renewal Proposal for Township Operations, 2023-2026 inclusive, on the upcoming August Primary election ballot was made by Mary; seconded by Cindy. All members voting yes.

Heather will get new updated taxable millage values for monies raised yearly through the proposal and Shirley will correct the millage values and correct yearly dates to turn into County Clerk before May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**NEW BUSINESS:** The Osceola County Road Commission sent emails out letting townships know that prices for having Fog and Chip seal done this summer would stay the same and if we are interested in getting it done in Cedar, to call and get it booked as soon as possible. Loren will check it out and get more information.

Hazardous Waste Removal donation:

● **MOTION** made by Ed; seconded by Mary to donate \$200.00 to the Mecosta and Osceola Lake Conservation District to help with hazardous waste disposal for Cedar residents . All members voting yes.

Shirley updated board on elections with all inspectors having to be re-certified this summer with training by county clerk. Also, the new re-districting map and how it effects Cedar
