

**CEDAR TOWNSHIP  
MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 20, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at Cedar Township Hall at 7:00 p.m., 9115 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Reed City, Michigan. Mr. Craig Thompson also addressed board about their idea to have races once a month with camping facilities on weekends for the racers. Board will need to look into it but feels the township, area neighbors, residents will need to input their voices before board makes any decision.
