

**CEDAR TOWNSHIP  
MINUTES  
JUNE 20, 2023**

The meeting was called to order at Cedar Township Hall at 7:00 p.m., 9115 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Reed City, Michigan. Supervisor calls meeting to order. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

**OLD BUSINESS:** 9 Mile Road repairs is still unsure on time line for finishing. Swamp area is still sinking and has yet to hold any of the sand that has been dumped in. Road Commissioner has asked for an engineer to come and do bore hole to determine where the bottom is and what it will take to fill and establish a solid base across the swamp area.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Board received a request from Road Commission about a petition received from residents on 11 Mile asking that the private road be switched to a county road. The cost to do this is more than the township road fund can cover this year. Thus, board has denied the request for 11 mile road at this time. Heather asked board about new tax software thru BS&A called Point N Pay. It will allow residents to pay taxes electronically and make paying their taxes quicker, easier, and allow for credit cards. Cost for initial setup is \$2000.00. Heather will get more info on this.

Planning Board Chairman, Chris Lockhart, submitted his resignation, effective immediately. Doug Lockhart also requested to be replaced, also.

Bills were presented for approval; moved by Mary, seconded by Heather, to approve checks 7713-7735.
