IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Make checks payable to Osceola County Building Department

Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Osceola County. All installations shall be in conformance with the State of Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

INSPECTIONS; When ready for an inspection, call the Osceola County Building Dept. (231)832-6117. Provide at least 24 hours notice for inspections.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 6 months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 6 months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO EXTEND A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00**
