Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District Announces Re-Opening of Berylwood Park Skate Plaza

Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District is pleased to announce that the Berylwood Park Skate Plaza has been re-opened as of Wednesday, August 19, 2020. The Skate Plaza was temporarily closed as the result of a lack of adherence by some individuals to State and County COVID-19 gathering and distancing requirements, as well as a lack of regard by some users for park rules and regulations.

The re-opening will coincide with a free membership registration, as well as designated skate times to allow for the safe and orderly use of the Plaza. With membership registration, participants of all ages can enjoy use of the Plaza between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. every day of the week and exclusive use for elementary age youth from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., middle school age youth from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and high school and older use from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. every day of the week.

Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District's Board Chair, Ed Abele, stated "I am pleased that the Skate Plaza is opening again after a brief closure. The new Plaza was built to allow exciting recreational opportunities for all ages. Our District takes pride in providing safe parks for the entire community. All users are encouraged to follow park rules and obey laws so that we may keep this amazing venue open going forward."

The free membership can be received online through the District's website at www.rsrpd.org under Online Registration or by visiting the District's administrative offices at the Activity Center located at 4201 Guardian Street, Simi Valley during business hours between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. For participants age 17 and under a parent/legal guardian will need to complete the registration.

The usage schedule and terms of use are subject to change should patrons and users not adhere to State and County public health orders and Park/Plaza rules and regulations.
