RANCHO SIMI RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT ANNOUNCES COMPLETION OF POST & CABLE REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN OAK PARK

The Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District is pleased to announce the recent completion of the Post and Cable Replacement Fire Recovery Project in Oak Park.

In November of 2018, the community of Oak Park, among others, was severely impacted by the Woolsey Fire. Included among the items impacted by the fire was the post and cable fencing that runs throughout the community.

The project focused on the replacement of the post and cable in 19 locations throughout the community of Oak Park that delineate trail heads and open space areas. The scope of the project included the removal and replacement of 8,100 linear feet of damaged cable as well as 260 posts that were either damaged or burned.

The Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District manages open space and parks in Oak Park which was originally part of Rancho Simi, a Spanish land concession given in 1795.
